Y6 Sports Captains: 10 Y6 girls competed against 27 other schools in the **ISA Netball Nationals** this week. We set of for a 2 hour journey but it ended up being a 4 hour journey because of an accident on the M6 and sadly missed out first match against Weston Green. At the end of our group stage, we had scored 85 goals and only conceded 5. We were undefeated in our group and got through to the cup which was the highest group. In the semi-finals we played The Study and won 11-6, which gave us a place in the final against Alderley Edge. We dominated the play and won 10-4 which meant we were the **ISA U11 NATIONAL NETBALL CHAMPIONS!!**

This is the third time in 4 years, we have won the nationals four times since joining ISA in 2017 and have been national netball champions in 2017, 2022,2023 and 2025!!


However, due to manufacturing processes, some products used in the school kitchen state that they 'may contain nuts/sesame'.
