Celebrating Innovation and Creativity in the ISA STEM Competition

We are delighted to share the exciting outcome of this year's ISA STEM Competition, which saw a fantastic number of pupils enthusiastically embrace the challenge of exploring engineering, design and problem-solving.

Pupils competed across two categories, each designed to stretch their creativity and technical thinking:

- Year 3 & 4 pupils were tasked with designing and building a paper rollercoaster strong enough to hold and carry a marble successfully.
- Year 5 & 6 pupils took on the challenge of designing and constructing a self-sustaining terrarium, requiring careful consideration of ecosystems, balance and long-term sustainability.

This competition was about far more than producing eye-catching designs. Pupils worked diligently to meet the specific criteria set by the ISA, developing essential STEM skills such as planning, testing, refining and evaluating their ideas. Throughout the process, they demonstrated impressive creativity, perseverance and thoughtful engineering, with every entry reflecting a genuine commitment to learning.

Judging the projects proved to be no easy task. Mrs McGrath, alongside our Year 6 STEM Captains, had the extremely difficult responsibility of selecting the entries that best fulfilled the competition criteria. With such a high standard of work across all submissions, the final decisions were particularly challenging.

Imogen Madden Brings Home Gold from Germany

Bowdon Preparatory School for Girls is bursting with pride as we celebrate the remarkable international success of Imogen Madden (Year 5), who recently competed in a prestigious international gymnastics competition in Germany, hosted by Gymfinity.

Gymfinity hosts an international friendly competition every December, welcoming gymnasts of all ages and abilities, from beginner through to elite level. This year's event brought together clubs from across the world, including the UK, USA, Germany, Switzerland, the Czech Republic, France, Spain, Italy, Portugal, Kosovo, Albania, Dubai and beyond, creating a truly global and highly competitive arena.

Imogen was selected to represent Great Britain for Gymfinity in the 9–10 age category – an exceptional honour and a testament to her dedication, talent and hard work. Competing against some of the very best young gymnasts internationally, Imogen delivered an outstanding performance, showcasing composure, strength and precision throughout her routines.

Her results were nothing short of extraordinary:

- 1st place on Beam
- 2nd place on Floor
- 1st place Overall, finishing as the top scorer in her age group




